Dear Neroche families,

I hope you all had a lovely break over the past two weeks. It has been great to see the children back in school today.

This morning, we met as a whole school for assembly in order to set a positive mindset for the term ahead, which included recapping our school values (be the best you can be, show that you care and shine bright) as well as our four school rules (be ready to learn, join in, be calm and respectful towards others and care for each other, the school and the environment). We also spoke about our Summer Term Awards. These awards are listed below:

Awards from staff:

- Weekly Star Awards certificates two certificates each week linked to the three school values or the four school rules
- House Points
- Raffle Tickets given for individual merit and put into the class jar. At the end of the week a ticket is pulled, and that person gets a prize. Tickets given for kindness/going above and beyond in class.
- Marble in a jar marbles added for class collaboration. When the jar is full (roughly once a half term) then the class get a treat, e.g. extra play/sports, 'Golden Time' type activities.

NEW Reading Award

- All children aiming for a Gold Reading Award during the summer term:
- Years 2 6 can earn a Gold Award linked to an Accelerated Reader target.
- Reception and Year 1 Read 15 books during the summer term to earn a Gold Award.
- The class that gets all Gold Awards first will win a £5 book token each.
- Any class who gets all their Gold Awards by Friday 12th July will get 3 new books for their class for next year (books decided within class by democratic vote).
- There is a new reading display in the hall to track the progress of each class and motivate all readers. If you need support with reading with your child, please speak with your child's class teacher.

NEW Writing Award

- Going for Gold in Writing Gold Star Writer Award.
- A Writer of the Week (Star Writer) award in each class from Preschool to Year 6.
- The writer of the week will get a certificate in assembly. The name of each pupil from each class will get displayed on the writing display board outside the Headteacher Office, along with a copy of their writing.
- Each writer of the week will get to write with the golden pen (KS2) or pencil (EYFS & KS1) for the following week and display the golden 'quill' trophy at their table during writing tasks.

Preschool awards

- 1 weekly care bug given to a child who has been showing care and kindness that week.
- 1 weekly bee badge given to a child who has really tried their best that week.
